Effective with summer 2009 matriculation (January 2009 application deadline), A.B.S.N. option applicants must have completed ALL science prerequisites, and B.S.N. option applicants must have completed at least three of the science prerequisites at the time of application. Effective January 2010 matriculation (August 2009 application deadline), ALL B.S.N. option applicants applying for January admission must have completed physiology as one of the science prerequisites at the time of application.
