♦ 18 hours ≥ C (not C-) required in major core. No more than 45 hours in any subject may be used toward 120 hours for graduation. **Seven additional courses approved by a faculty advisor (appointed by director in consultation with student).** Students are also strongly encouraged to take at least one course on matters of social/cultural difference/diversity, such as ANTH 380, COMM 318, or RELI 323. Students are also strongly encouraged to take at least one class on contemporary theory such as COMM 412.

Students are required to take classes in at least three departments. No more than four courses (12 hours) in the same department may count toward the major. A student should strengthen his or her course of study by choosing Approaches, Connections, and elective courses that complement courses in cultural studies.

Students with an overall GPA of 3.3 or above and a GPA of 3.3 or above in cultural studies courses are encouraged to undertake an honors thesis project during the senior year for a total of six credit hours (COMM 691H and 692H). These hours will be in addition to the 24 hours (eight courses) minimally required for the major.
