(#) A grade of B- or better is required in BIOL 252/L, MCRO 251, and PHYI 292/BIOL 253/L (or approved equivalents) and must have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline. A grade of C or better is required in PSYC 101 and STOR 151/155 (or approved equivalents) within 10 years of the application deadline. STOR 155 is strongly recommended for students interested in graduate study. \*\*PHYI 292 will no longer be offered at UNC-CH, effective Fall 2020, but may still be transferred from another school.

(##) Applicants must have completed at least three of the key science prerequisites by the application deadline. Key science prerequisites are BIOL 252/252L, PHYI 292 or BIOL 253/L, MCRO 251, PSYC 101 and STOR 151/155. **For applicants seeking admission for May 2022 or later an average GPA of at least 3.0 must be earned in the five key science prerequisites, and an average 3.0 GPA must be earned in all key science courses completed at the time of application.**

Admission to the School of Nursing is competitive. The minimum cumulative grade point average for admission to the B.S.N. option is a 2.8 on a 4.0 scale. Students are admitted to the upper-division (junior/senior) B.S.N. (five-semester) option, typically in the spring semester of the sophomore year. Students must complete all lower-division (first-year/sophomore) courses by the end of the spring semester prior to matriculating into the School of Nursing.
