CHECKLIST FOR GETTING STARTED

First Steps after Admission:

1. Please review the transfer credit report e-mail from the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. All admitted transfer students should receive a report within two weeks of initial acceptance. If you have not received this report after two weeks, please contact Admissions (unchelp@admissions.unc.edu) to inquire about your transfer credit report.
2. Please contact the Registrar from your previous institution to request an official final transcript. This will need to be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at UNC-Chapel Hill. When requesting your final transcripts, please be sure that it includes your degree award date (if any) as well as final grades.

Next Steps for Newly Admitted Transfer Students prior to meeting with an advisor:
