In preparation for your transition, we have provided important information below that will help get you ready for registration.

## **CHECKLIST FOR GETTING STARTED**

- To register for classes, you need to be activated in the University system. To be activated, you must pay your enrollment deposit. Activation typically happens overnight once the deposit is submitted. The earliest you can register for Fall 2023 classes is April 15, 2023. Please be sure to review all your resources (see below) prior to trying to register for courses.
- 2. Please watch the online Rise 360 advising module <u>Transfer Student Fall 2023</u>. This is a comprehensive guide to the undergraduate curriculum, transfer credit, course registration, and planning resources. The module is a valuable tool for fully understanding your transfer experience.
- 3. Please send your official final transcript to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at UNC at Chapel Hill. Please be sure that it includes your final grades and degree award date if you are completing an Associate's degree from a community college.

## PREPARING FOR REGISTRATION

Your registration period begins on April 15, 2023, and closes at midnight on June 26, 2022. It opens again on August 7, 2023, for all continuing undergraduate students through the first week of classes. You have plenty of time to register so please be sure to review resources.

<u>We encourage you to attend one of our upcoming TRANSFER webinars.</u> These webinars will provide an overview of the registration process and give you an opportunity to ask questions. These will also be recorded and posted on the academic advising website.

Please note that students register for courses on their own, thus it is important to know how to navigate the process.

- Review the UNC <u>online catalog</u> to learn more about majors, minors, general education requirements, polices, etc. This guide features all policies, procedures and requirements for all degrees offered at the University. Please be sure to check the 2022-2023 version (mid-June) for the most up-to-date information as it relates to the upcoming academic year.
- ➤ Use the What-If Report for Newly Admitted Students Microsoft Word Pre-Matriculation What\_If Report.docx (unc.edu). The What-If report will indicate where your transfer credit fall within the undergraduate curriculum. Please note that you should receive your transfer credit report before running this tool.

## Meeting with an Academic Advisor

Once you have attended a webinar, completed the Transfer Student Module, received your transfer credit report, and have further questions, students can utilize academic advising dropin hours or register for a scheduled appointment.

Students (paid enrollment deposit) can attend drop-in hours or schedule an appointment (<u>See an advisor</u>) with an academic advisor. Please note that the appointment scheduler is restricted to students who have an active ONYEN. **Appointments will be limited in April which is why we recommend the webinars and drop-ins (if needed)**. Additionally, appointments are only available 15 days in advance.

If you have not paid your enrollment deposit and are deciding on attending UNC, please be sure to attend a webinar, complete the Transfer Student Module, and receive your transfer credit report prior to connecting with advising. Should you still have questions, students can <u>schedule</u> <u>an appointment</u> with an academic advisor April 26 – May 6 (click "Guest" option). *Please note that drop-in advising is only active for students who have submitted their enrollment deposit.*
