- Utilize resources such as the Rise 360 Transfer Module, the Undergraduate Catalog, and other resources
- Encourage exploration
- Empower students to make decisions & take responsibility
- Normalize help-seeking behaviors
- Communicate about progress

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

- At 18 years old, students own their educational records.
- Your student needs to give FERPA authorization for us to talk with you
- Student gives authorization by creating a specific PIN



Semester Course Load

- 12-18 credit hours is full time status
- 15-17 credit hours is recommended
- 120 credit hours minimum for graduation
- 8-10 semesters total from all institutions, excluding summers

Registration for Classes

- Registration is open 24/7 beginning April 12 – June 26
- Ability to edit course schedule:
August 7 – August 25
- Some courses require placement scores and/or pre-requisites
