The UNC Advising office in the College of Arts & Sciences would like to extend a warm welcome on your acceptance to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. We are excited to begin working with you this upcoming Fall 2024 semester. In preparation for your transition, we have provided important information below that will help get you ready for registration.

### CHECKLIST FOR GETTING STARTED

1. To register for classes on [ConnectCarolina](#), you need to be activated in the University system. To be activated, you must pay your enrollment deposit. Activation typically happens overnight once the deposit is submitted. The earliest you can register for Fall 2024 classes is **April 15**. Please be sure to review all your resources (see below) prior to trying to register for courses.
2. Please watch the online Rise 360 advising module – [Transfer Students Fall 2024](#). This is a comprehensive guide to the undergraduate curriculum, transfer credit, course registration, and planning resources. The module is a valuable tool for fully understanding your transfer experience.
3. Please [send your official final transcript](#) to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at UNC at Chapel Hill. Please be sure that your transcript includes your final grades and degree award date if you are completing an Associate's degree from a community college.

### PREPARING FOR REGISTRATION

Your registration period begins on April 15 and closes at 11:59pm on May 31. Enrollment will reopen on August 5 and will remain open through the first week of classes. You have plenty of time to register so please be sure to review the resources in this letter.

We encourage you to attend one of our upcoming TRANSFER webinars. These webinars will provide an overview of the registration process and give you an opportunity to ask questions. You can sign up to attend a webinar on Slate via your UNC Admissions MyCarolina portal.

### Meeting with an Academic Advisor

**If you have questions after you have attended a webinar, completed the Transfer Student Module, and received your transfer credit report**, you are invited to utilize academic advising virtual drop-in hours on Zoom or register for a scheduled appointment (Zoom, phone, or in person options available).

Students who have paid their enrollment deposit can attend virtual drop-in hours or schedule an appointment ([See an Advisor - UNC Advising](#)) with an academic advisor. Please note that the appointment scheduler is restricted to students who have an active ONYEN. **Appointments will be limited in April which is why we recommend attending the virtual webinars and advising drop-in hours (if needed)**. Additionally, please note advising appointments are available up to 21 days in advance.

If you have not paid your enrollment deposit and are deciding on attending UNC, please be sure to attend a webinar, complete the Transfer Student Module, and review your transfer credit report prior to connecting with advising. Should you still have questions, students can schedule a virtual appointment with an academic advisor between April 22-May 15 by visiting this link: <https://hubappts.oasis.unc.edu/guests/>. *Please note that drop-in advising is only active for students who have submitted their enrollment deposit.*
